Financial Report for the period 2019 to June 2023

The Finance Committee of our parish presents this report to assist parishioners and supporters in your understanding of our financial journey of recent years.

The report indicates that the decline in collections that accompanied COVID-19 in 2020 has continued to impact us adversely. This impact is not unique to us, as we all would know. Many institutions were, and are, significantly affected. Further, we are all aware the cost of living has gone up. There have been income sources that are one-off in nature, principally, the Jobseeker supplement from the Australian Government in 2020, and cash settlements for insurance matters, principally water damage in the office & hall. The repairs to the hall and office are currently underway and will exhaust the insurance cash settlement.

An additional valuable source of income is the rental of the presbytery to a religious order.

Regarding our Parish, it is obvious that parishioner numbers are down and thus collections are down. Even if we double this year's collection to date, it will be below prior years.


It is noted that when the larger one-off income sources are excluded, there are ongoing deficits. We have been fortunate to date to receive some bequests, but we understand present bequests have now run their course. We thank these donors for their ongoing support.

As with us all, our parish incurs the rising cost of services, such as electricity, water, maintenance etc. There are cash reserves that will offset losses in the short term, but it will be crucial for the longer-term viability of our parish that we are able to balance our budget.

We have been active in looking at other avenues. Thanks to the fantastic efforts of fellow parishioners, we have been successful in obtaining additional sources of funding through various grant programs. The funding has enabled improvements to the hall, toilets, the construction of a large storage shed and the purchase of maintenance equipment. All are valuable assets.

In closing, if we parishioners can manage any additional financial support this will greatly assist our parish. We greatly appreciate all your collective efforts to support the parish that is so special to us.

Thank you for that we do, in so many areas, to foster our parish.
