Archbishop Mark has a message for you...

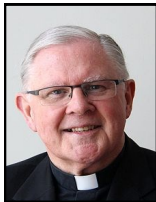
This week we focus on Indigenous reconciliation and what it requires.

Everyone agrees there's a need for reconciliation and that the current state of affairs is unacceptable.

But not all agree on what needs to happen. Much of what we've tried in the past has achieved little or nothing, and sometimes it's been clearly counterproductive. At times there have been gestures that make some of us feel better but change nothing on the ground.

We need not the aesthetics of change but real change at a deeper level. That's why the Uluru Statement from the Heart proposes a triple path of voice, truth-telling and treaty.

It's a serious attempt to go beneath the symptoms to treat the cause of chronic Indigenous disadvantage. A politician said to me recently that we don't need a voice to parliament but more services on the ground. All I could say in reply is that we need both.

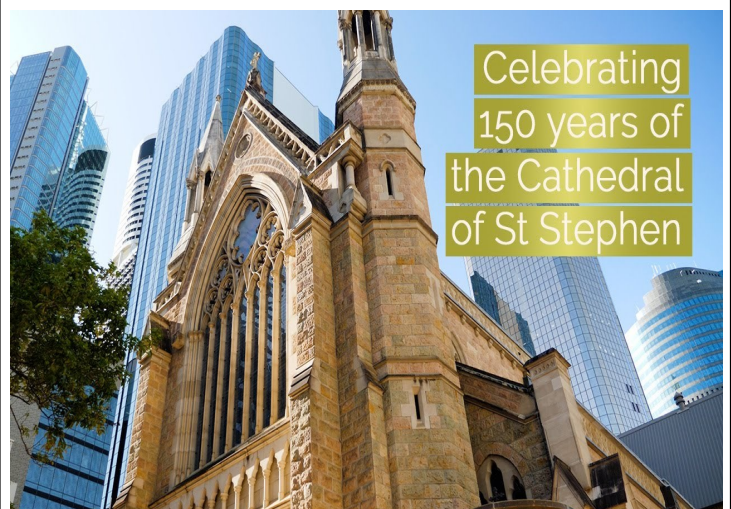
